ABSTRACT Guidelines:

A. Abstract Preparation Guidelines:

Abstract should be prepared in the following format:

- **TITLE SHOULD BE ALL UPPER CASE, TIMES NEW ROMAN, 12 FONT SIZE AND BOLD**
- All Authors Name, Surname should be in 'Times New Roman', 11 Font Size and the presenting author's name should be underlined.
- Mentor Name* [for research fellows/postdoctoral associates, * sign should be given at mentor's name]
- *Institutes of the authors would be Times New Romans italics, 11 Font Size, [Presenting author e-mail should be there in next line, Times New Roman, 10 Font Size]*
- Abstract word limit 300 words
- Key Words: 5 keywords. [Times New Romans, 11 Font Size]
- *Mentor's affiliation and e-mail

B. Guideline for Award Category:

- The research work should have been conducted in India
- Review articles will not be considered

C. Abstract submission Procedure in The Online Portal

Abstracts can only be submitted through the conference's online registration system (link available in the conference flyer and can be accessed in the Bose Institute website). Each abstract should be uploaded in the 'Word document' file (.doc/.docx). Submissions through e-mail or any other method will not be accepted.

D. Specify Submission Category:

In the online submission form, it is required to select the type of abstract submission category from the following options:

- Poster presentation
- Oral presentation

E. Awards:

Three awards in each category **sponsored by Wiley with certificate** will be given to best poster and oral presentation
