- **Essential Qualification** : A good M.Sc. / M.Tech. in Life Science, Biotechnology, Biochemistry and Bioinformatics with valid GATE.
- **Fellowship** : Rs. 25,000/- p.m. plus admissible HRA.
- **Age** : Below 28 years as on the day on which the application is made (relaxable in case of SC/ST/OBC/Women candidates only as per rules)
